## **A specialty with few professional opportunities**

FALSE. Hematology is a specialty with a high demand and labor projection, both in the public and private sector. Hematologists can work in hospitals, health centres, blood banks, clinical laboratories, research, or teaching centers. We also collaborate with other medical specialties for advice/support.

## **A boring and monotonous specialty**

FALSE. Hematology is a dynamic, varied specialty requiring updated knowledge of diseases, laboratory techniques, and therapies, while fostering rewarding human and professional relationships with patients and families.

## Overview of the program



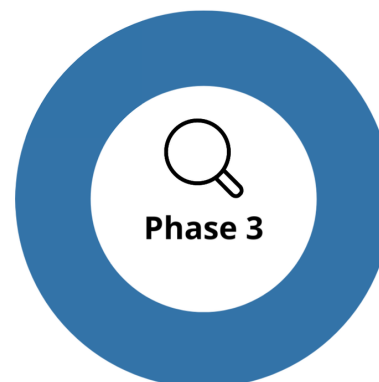
24/7/365 access to the online campus: interviews, podcasts and live online workshops:

- More practical approaches to hematology, etc.

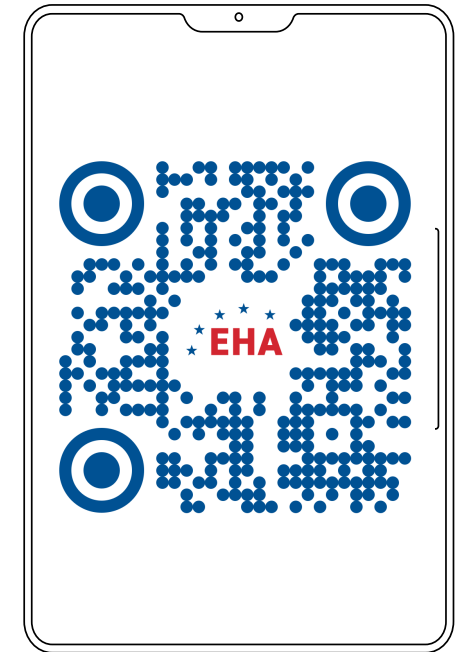
## Lighting the Flame program goal:
